Now, Red Flag F-5-pilots-imitate-MIG-21 fighter pilots, doing their best to "shoot down" American B-52s, F-15 Eagles, F-4 Phantoms, A-70 Corsairs and practically every other plane in the U.S. inventory during daily aerial combat exercises.

And "American" planes react in kind trying to "destroy" the MIG-like F-5s, penetrating "Soviet" defenses to rain live bombs, rockets and missiles on simulated Communist targets on the desert floor.

The elite of U.S. fighter pilots are members of the 64th and 65th "aggressor" MIG-like fighter squadrons. They think like Russian pilots think and they fly the F-5s like Russians fly MIGs — using the same formations, and tactics.

They simulate firing of Russian Atoll missiles and other Soviet weaponry from the compact, highly maneuverable F-5 Tigers

When not flying missions over the desert, pilots spend hours studying manuals on Russian MIG tactics.

If those figures sound a far cry from the 50,000-50,000 attendance figures bandied about for the weekend, the disparity is a function of the way things are counted — by "admissions."

Vignettes abound at this. Jubilee. Pud Brown, for instance, is on the scene and playing-beautifully despite the heart attack that hit him in February while playing in New Orleans' Mardi Gras parade.

the rapist said during the attack.

During his last reported rape on May 17 in the Del Dayo area, the rapist threatened to kill his next two victims.

Miller said sheriff's deputies were convinced, that Saturday's intruder was the east area rapist and not an imitator because "there are alot of things about the rapist" that are not publicly known and thus would not be known to an imitator.

Why did the rapist move south?

"Possibly, it could have been due to all the publicity the EARS Patrol has been receiving," Miller said.

The EARS (East Area Rapist Surveillance) Patrol is a group of more than 100 Sacramento residents with citizen band radios that has been cruising the east area at night since last Thursday.

EARS Chairman Ed Nannini said Saturday that up to 75 members of his group were patroling Friday night.

Nannini said that the total reward for information leading to the capture of the rapist has been increased to \$30,000 and issued an appeal for more volunteers with base and mobile citizen band radio units.

The sheriff's office has increased patrols using cars and helicopters and has been allocated \$100,000 for overtime pay in the search.

A sheriff's spokesman said Saturday night that some extramanpower would be shifted south as a result of the latest attack. Besides the authorized overtime duty, the spokesman said, many deputies are donating their time for added patrols, and some California Highway Patrol officers have volunteered their time. City—police—are—also working on special details.

The rapist has been described as white, between 20 and 30 years old. Fear of the man has touched off increased sales of guns, guard dogs and alarm systems throughout the area.

### Justice Departm To Press AT&T A

WASHINGTON — The Justice Department announced Saturday that it would proceed to press its antitrust case against the American Telephone & Telegraph Co. as a result of a decision last Thursday by the United States Court of Appeals.

In a decision by Judges David L..

Bazelon and Malcolm R. Wilkey, the court ordered that a stay on court proceedings be lifted and also denied the huge concern's petition for a writ calling up proceedings from an inferior court for review.

### Dutch Warn Mo Against Hurting

GLIMMEN, The Netherlands (UPI) — Dutch officials warned Saturday that combat troops might attack a hijacked passenger train in northern Holland if South Moluccan terrorists harm even one of their 56 hostages.

Four teachers also were held at an elementary school in Bovensmilde, 15-miles away, where a second band of gunmen released more than 100 children hostages Friday.

Since the release, officials have maintained intensive negotiations with the gunmen at both locations. Friday night, troops in armored cars and a convoy of 18 military ambulances moved to a rail crossing near the halted train.
